### County to help fund fire station in eastern Wildomar

RIVERSIDE -- The county Board of Supervisors agreed Thursday to contribute funding for a second fire station on or near Clinton Keith Road and east of Interstate 15 in Wildomar.

The five supervisors voted for an arrangement by which the county would split the costs of the fire station with what is expected to become the city of Wildomar during the next fiscal year.

The approval didn't cover a specific breakdown of costs, but directed the county fire department, which already provides coverage to the area, to work out an arrangement with leaders of the eventual city.

Fire officials and supervisors said they expect the growing community to require a second station to augment fire coverage of the existing station west of I-15.
